(2005)

It was nominated for four Oscars, including for best script, best editing, and Rachel Weisz for best supporting actress.

### No Country for Old Men

(2007)

Based on the Cormac McCarthy novel, this Coen brothers movie that they wrote, directed, edited, and co-produced is about a hunter stumbling upon the fortune from a drug deal gone wrong. It was nominated for eight Oscars, including for best cinematography and best editing, and it won four: for best picture, best director, best script, and Javier Bardem for best supporting actor as the iconically weird psycho killer.

### Bad Teacher

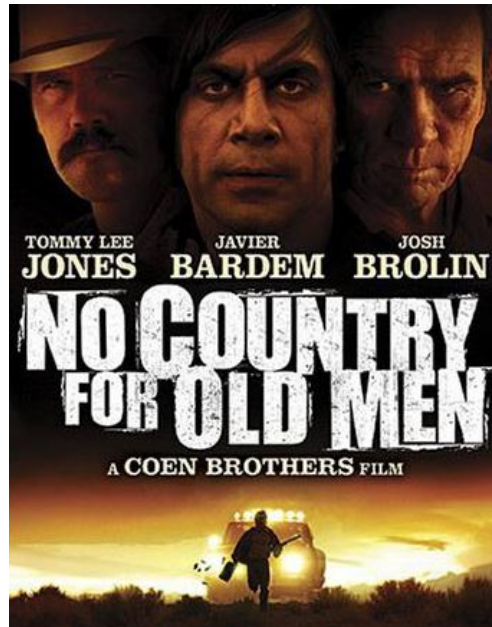
(2011)
